(a) Use the trial wavefunction

$$\begin{aligned}\psi &= [\psi_0 + ue^{i(kx-\omega t)} + v^* e^{-i(kx-\omega t)}] e^{-i\mu t/\hbar} \\ &= [\psi_0 + \delta\psi(t)] e^{-i\mu t/\hbar},\end{aligned}$$

instead. Furthermore show that the second equation is

$$\mu\delta\psi + i\hbar\frac{d}{dt}(\delta\psi(t)) = \frac{\hbar^2 k^2}{2M}\delta\psi(t) + g|\psi_0|^2 2\delta\psi(t) + g\psi_0^2\delta\psi^*(t).$$
